

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ACTM CONSTITUTION AND BY LAWS

To be voted on at the ACTM Business Meeting on October 21, 2011

Rationale –

A part of the ACTM dues was designated to be given to the *Alabama Journal of Mathematics* to support its printing and publication. Recently the publication has moved to an online format. There is no longer a need to fund the printing and publication of the *Journal*. The publication is now available at www.ajmonline.org.

The proposed amendment to the by-laws would remove the requirement that \$2.00 of the ACTM dues and \$12.00 of the Elementary School Building Membership dues be given to the *Alabama Journal of Mathematics*. The amount of the dues remains unchanged. In paragraph 3, the statement that “the school will receive one copy of the Alabama Journal of Mathematics” should be removed since there is no longer a print copy. The online copy will be available to all.

Current wording:

BY LAWS, Article III. Dues, Paragraph 2.

Allocation of dues shall be: (a) one (1) dollar per membership – to the respective districts; (b) two (2) dollars per membership – to the treasurer of the Alabama Journal of Mathematics.

Proposed wording:

BY LAWS, Article III. Dues, Paragraph 2.

Allocation of dues shall be: (a) one (1) dollar per membership – to the respective districts; (b) the remainder to the Alabama Council of Teachers of Mathematics.

Current Wording:

BY LAWS, Article III, Dues, Paragraph 3.

Elementary schools shall have the option to apply for an Elementary School Building Membership with annual dues of thirty (30) dollars. These dues shall be allocated as follows: (a) twelve (12) dollars to the Alabama Journal of Mathematics; (b) six (6) dollars to the District; (c) twelve (12) dollars to the Alabama Council of Teachers of Mathematics. It is the responsibility of someone in the building to keep an updated list and to submit this list to the membership chair. Benefits of this option are that the school will receive one copy of the Alabama Journal of Mathematics and all teachers will be allowed to attend the ACTM Conference at the membership rate.

Proposed Wording:

BY LAWS, Article III, Dues, Paragraph 3.

Elementary schools shall have the option to apply for an Elementary School Building Membership with annual dues of thirty (30) dollars. These dues shall be allocated as follows: (a) six (6) dollars to the District; (b) the remainder to the Alabama Council of Teachers of Mathematics. It is the responsibility of someone in the building to keep an updated list and to submit this list to the membership chair. Benefits of this option are that all teachers will be allowed to attend the ACTM Conference at the membership rate.
